

# EASY DIY SALT DOUGH EASTER EGGS

## *Salt Dough Easter Eggs – Supply List*

- 1 cup flour
- 1/2 cup salt
- 1/2 cup water
- rolling pin
- ruler, to measure dough thickness
- egg shape cutter
- spatula
- straw, for making holes
- parchment-paper covered baking sheets
- spray or acrylic paint
- paint pens, optional
- clear coat sealer, optional
- twine, ribbon

Stir together all three ingredients until a dough forms. Kneading the dough a couple times can help make it smoother.

Roll it out (I rolled mine to 1/4 inch thick) and cut out desired shapes. Place the salt dough Easter eggs on the parchment-covered baking sheets. Remember to make a hole so you can hang the ornaments — a straw works perfectly! Bake at 250F for 2 hours.

Once the shapes are adequately baked, dried and then thoroughly cooled, it's painting time. I like using spray paint because it's faster and easier but acrylics work just as well. Allow the paint to thoroughly dry. Use paint pens to add polka dots or lines of decorations to the eggs.



Optional: To further protect the color and design, add a clear coat sealer.

Loop twine or ribbon through the holes and hang.
