

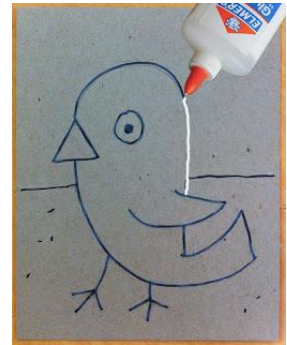
FOIL ART

MATERIALS

- Cardboard or Cardstock
- Pen or Thin Marker
- White glue
- Aluminum foil
- Toothpick [optional]

DIRECTIONS

1. Make a large simple drawing on cardboard or cardstock with a pencil and trace with a thin marker or pen. Trace all the lines with white glue and let dry for at least 24 hours.



2. Rub the entire drawing with a glue stick. Cover ALL of the cardboard. Any missed spots will not stick to the foil and cannot be “etched” later with the stylus.



3. Tear a sheet of aluminum foil and press to chipboard, shiny side up.

Wrap edges around the sides and glue in place.



4. Rub around edges of the glue with a Q-tip.

The better the rubbing, the more defined the drawing.



5. If you'd like to add detail, you can use a toothpick to draw details.
