BOARD MINUTES

9/15/2025

The Farwell ISD Board of Trustees met for a regular board meeting at 7:00 pm in the Farwell ISD Administration Building at 805 Ave G, Farwell, Texas.

Members Board present were; Ryan Williams, Joe Jaime, Ashley Nichols, Eric McElroy, Vince Smith, Brandon Smith, and Mario Vidaurri.

Meeting opened up at 7:03 pm with a prayer by Joe Jaime, followed by the pledge.

Public Comment made by Les Ball on home school students being allowed to participate in extra-curricular activities.

Motion made by Vince Smith and seconded by Mario Vidaurri to approve the consent agenda. Motion passed all in favor.

Principals reported that enrollment is now at 573. Upcoming school activities.

Shane Perkins, AD, discussed upcoming athletic events.

Vince Smith moved and Ashley Nichols seconded that the Board adopt the Resolution to renew the District's good cause exceptions from the requirements of Texas Education Code section 37.0814 and renew the District's alternative standard for use of school guardians as set in Board Policy and District Regulation, and further authorize the superintendent to take any and all action necessary to continue implementation and use of the District's alternative standard for maintaining compliance with Texas Education Code section 37.0814. Motion passed all in favor.

Colby Waldrop, Superintendent, informed the school that CKED regulation has been updated to include New Mexico employees that have their license to carry and are employed by the district are now eligible if the board should approve them in the future.

Flex Engineering and Huseman Builders presented the board drawings and 3D images of a proposed concession stand and restroom project. Board asked questions on cost and ways to save including reducing size and not having dropped ceilings. The Board discussed that now they would like to continue to proceed to find out more information to get a better idea of cost.

Colby Waldrop, Superintendent, discussed the look for a water leak continues and that the school is not having any luck finding the leak that the city says we have.
