The Seamless Summer Meals is the USDA nutrition program administered to the Lone Star State by the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) For the children who rely on school meals during the academic year, these meals offer a source of good nutrition when school if out for the summer.

The summer meal Program will provide Breakfast 8:00 am- 10:00 am and Lunch 11:00 am until 1:00 pm Monday through Thursday Starting June 1st and ending on June 30th.
