- Written tests; students will be learning based on MusicFirst, this is a program
 designed to teach the students rhythms, counting, key words and phrases used

- Holiday Concert; the students are expected to perform at the end of the semester holiday concert. Music will be passed out and prepared months in advance.
- All Region Auditions: not all students are required to audition for All Region, but it is an excellent opportunity. As a band we will all be looking at the All Region audition music and scales and prepare them together. Even though not everyone will be auditioning, learning the music is a fine skill to have.
- Honor Band Auditions: Honor Band is a step up from All Region, this music will
 only be passed out to those who are interested in auditioning. They will work

on preparing this music primarily on their own. The directors are always available before and after school to help out with any issues.
