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Classroom Behavior: Respect

1. To be respected, you need to be respectful. Having courteous actions and polite speech will earn you respect. Your attitude will determine your ability to perform well in class and in life.
2. Please leave food outside the classroom. Drinks are allowed; the container must have a lid that will not fall off, no flimsy plastic.
3. When the bell rings, **be in your seat** and begin your focus. Place your completed homework on your desk. Record your daily assignments in your binder under the first tab.
4. Cell phones must be turned off **completely**.
5. Please visit the restroom between classes. Each semester, two hall passes are provided. The subsequent passes will count as a tardy.

Daily work, homework & long-term assignments: Responsibility

To build strong reading and writing skills, you will need to practice these skills which require homework. Practice includes making mistakes and trying again!!!!

1. Long-term and in-class assignments are due on the date listed on the board. Most of the time, you will have two days or more to prepare your homework. Use your class time wisely; you may work ahead.
2. You will receive a check for bell work and assignments completed on time. These assignments may or may not be graded. For each missing assignment, 5 points will be deducted from your on-time homework grade, which begins with a 100.
3. Write the heading for all assignments in the **upper right margin** of your paper. Follow directions.

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Late Work/Makeup Work/Absences: Accountability

1. At the end of each six weeks, you will take home a parent letter and performance report with your assignment folder. When you return the letter, performance report, and folder with your parent's and your signature by the designated date, you will receive a 100 for a homework grade. Parents may come to the classroom at any time to check your folders **which must stay in the classroom** except for the two days for parental observation.
2. Each day the assignments are written on the board and in the notebook at the front of the class. Check the notebook before asking for assignments. You may complete any missed assignments within the required time limit. If the assignment was assigned while you are in class, it is due when you return from your absence.
3. One of your responsibilities, as a student, is to turn in your assignments on time. Unexpected circumstances will occur that can alter the best intentions. Discuss the situation with me.
4. If you know you will be absent, ask for your assignments ahead of time. Then you can manage your time, keep your goal of passing this class, the EOC (10th grade), and earn your diploma.

Class Attitude: Respect/Fairness

If you are talking, showing-off, using your phone, and/or being disrespectful, marks will be recorded for each offense. The marks will continue until you control yourself. **Detention will be assigned if needed!** Choose to be respectful and thoughtful, and you will create a quality learning environment for your peers and you.
