PARMER COUNTY SWCD COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

The Parmer County Soil and Water Conservation District is providing a scholarship to any **Parmer County** high school senior planning to major in Agriculture in college. Funds will be sent to the financial aid officer of the recipient's College at the rate specified. The funds are to reimburse the college for the student's tuition, fees, and books or both in the amount not to exceed the total specified sum. The unexpended balance of the scholarship may be used to defray other legitimate expenses incidental to college attendance. The scholarship will be confined to an applicant who enrolls in Agriculture related courses.

Amount of Scholarship

The scholarship is for \$1,200.00 to be used in 1 year at the rate of \$600.00 per semester, which will be dispersed in two equal payments.

Eligibility

Any current year graduating senior is eligible to apply for the Parmer County Soil and Water Conservation District Scholarship Program. It is mandatory that the scholarship winner attends college in the fall semester immediately following selection. A high school transcript signed by a school official responsible for scholarships, should accompany the application. Please include a teacher's recommendation with your application.

Selection

Applicants should submit in essay form, a summary of achievements and why they feel the need and are best qualified for the scholarship, not to be over two pages in length. The Parmer County SWCD board of directors will serve as the selection committee. Qualification for the scholarship will be based on need, record of scholarship and record of accomplishments.

Due Date

Scholarship application is due in the Parmer County SWCD office at 109 3rd Street in Farwell by 12:00 P.M. (noon) on **Friday, May 5th, 2023**. If mailed, send to P.O. Box 359, Farwell, Texas 79325.

Follow Up

- 1) Student ID, college scholarship office address and a minimum of twelve (12) semester hour fall class schedule is necessary for the first installment.
- 2) College transcript or grades showing a 2.5 GPA and a minimum of twelve (12) semester hour spring class schedule is required for the second installment.
